1) Dress Code

a) Student Dress Code

Proper attire shows self-respect and respect for others. Dress of students should be clean, neat and within the limits of good taste. Shoulders, midriffs, backs and thighs are to be covered (i.e., no halter tops, spaghetti straps, short shorts/skirts) and hats/bandanas are not to be worn in the school. Clothing, accessories/school bags with inappropriate wording or graphics (e.g. racist, sexist, weapons, drug/alcohol related messages) are prohibited. Appropriate footwear for daily school activities is required. Outdoor shoes or boots should be changed for dry, non-scuffing indoor shoes. Bare feet or stocking feet are not acceptable at any time and high heels, flip flops, and/or wheeled shoes are discouraged for safety reasons. Students will be directed to change if they are wearing inappropriate clothing.
