## 3. Grade 6 (EF6A) Update

- As part of the oldest group of students at ACES, we are looking for and finding new/innovative ways for students to collaborate given the new COVID-related limitations. We are grateful for the support of families who have allowed their child to take their personal Chrome Book to school, which in combination with a number of school-owned Chrome books, allow us to use technology daily. While these Chrome books are used in more traditional ways, such as research, or writing, students are also using technology to connect with each other even within the classroom by using different software and apps. To name a few:
  - Google Meet for small group tasks and projects.
  - o **Pallet** for brainstorming and sharing thoughts and ideas in a visible way,
  - Google Docs, Slides and Jam board to consolidate their thinking in a way that is easily shared with teachers and/or the rest of the class,
  - o **Google Classroom** to organize and easily access school work at school or at home, as necessary.
- In line with the Grade 6 Health curriculum requirements, we are trialing an interactive online product from Media Smarts that is usually only available by paid license: <u>Passport to the Internet</u>. Through this educational game, students will learn critical thinking skills they need to apply to their online experiences, including online safety, authenticating online information, recognizing online marketing ploys, protecting their privacy, managing online relationships and dealing with cyberbullying. We will report back on our findings re: depth of learning, and ease of use. Thanks! Adrianna
